







THANKS TO GOVERNMENT POLICIES **MALAWI HAS ACHIEVED MDG4 EARLY**

Malawi was one of the earliest and fastest adopters of internationally recognised policies to save child lives.

IN MALAWI SURVIVED TO THE AGE OF 5.

BY 2013, 93 OUT OF **EVERY 100 CHILDREN** IN MALAWI REACHED THE AGE OF 5.

TOO MANY NEWBORNS DIE

Improvements in child survival since 1990 have mainly been for those aged 1 month to 5 years. Newborn survival has not improved at the same rate.
